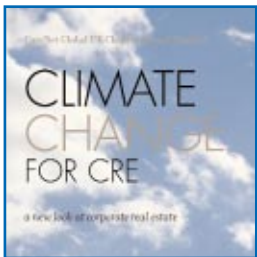

## Professional development

The University of Reading continues to run its highly rated series of quality professional development courses aimed at busy real estate professionals, for example:

### Planning and Environmental Management 27 Nov - 1 Dec 2006

This course aims to develop an awareness and knowledge of the way in which sustainability is being integrated into the policy, practice and procedures of planning and property development.

### CRE within Dynamic Organisations 29 Nov - 1 Dec 2006

This course draws involves visits to three organizations (in the past, Prudential, Vodafone, Siemens and WorldCom, for example) to discuss recent management ideas and investigate how these are impacting in practice.

### CRE Management: Strategy and Practice 12 - 16 Feb 2007

This interactive course will help you gain a greater understanding of the link between organisational planning and the management of the property resource, whilst providing a good oversight of trends in the corporate real estate arena.

## Porritt keynote at UK Summit

Jonathon Porritt, Co-Founder of Forum for the Future and an eminent writer, broadcaster and commentator on sustainable development is the keynote speaker at the forthcoming UK Summit (16 November, Congress Centre, London WC1 – secure your place now at [www.sasevents.co.uk/events/cngsummit.html](http://www.sasevents.co.uk/events/cngsummit.html))

Jonathon was appointed by the Prime Minister as Chairman of the UK Sustainable Development Commission in July 2000. This is the Government's principal source of independent advice across the whole sustainable development agenda. In addition, he has been a member of the Board of the South West Regional Development Agency since December 1999, and is Co-Director of The Prince of Wales's Business and Environment Programme which runs Senior Executives' Seminars in Cambridge, Salzburg, South Africa and the USA. In 2005 he became a Non-Executive Director of Wessex Water, and a Trustee of the Ashden Awards for Sustainable Energy. He is also Vice-President of the Socialist Environment Resources Association (SERA).

He was formerly Director of Friends of the Earth (1984-90); co-chair of the Green Party (1980-83) of which he is still a member; chairman of UNED-UK (1993-96); chairman of Sustainability South West, the South West Round Table for Sustainable Development (1999-2001); a Trustee of WWF UK (1991-2005).

His latest book, Capitalism As If The World Matters (Earthscan), was published in November 2005.

Jonathon received a CBE in January 2000 for services to environmental protection.
